Dear Independence Hill Family,

It is after prayer and seeking wisdom, I have submitted my resignation as Senior Pastor of Independence Hill Baptist Church. For the last few years, I have been feeling a call to plant a church. But this wouldn't be the normal church plant. This ministry will be done covocationally. This kind of church doesn't need large group space to meet for Sunday services. It is called a network of micro-churches.

The goal of this type of network is to multiply home groups. Two guiding principles would be this organization doesn't depend on property or paid staff. The vision is to connect and disciple those who aren't going to church anywhere. This is also a focus of the North American Mission Board. They are launching a support team and resources this year for micro-church networks.

For almost 2 years, I have been working most Fridays and Saturdays at Apex Express Logistics. Apex is a DSP, delivery service provider, for Amazon. The Amazon trucks that deliver packages to homes are staffed and managed by DSPs. I have been one of their dispatchers. I have accepted a full-time position as Operations Manager for Apex. This is the necessary step to support my family before planting this new type of church.

My Apex schedule will be Wednesday through Saturday. After meeting with the Personnel Team, we agreed upon a three-month transition. Starting October 2, I will work Sunday, Monday, and Tuesday at Independence Hill with my salary adjusting accordingly. I will also handle pastoral care needs as they arise on days I am not at the church.

Furthermore, I will not immediately launch this new ministry after my time at IHBC concludes. I love Independence Hill and want the best for you. I don't want to be part of anything that could be interpreted as divisive. A micro-church network will take time and training to organize. I have no set date to launch the church I feel God guiding me to lead.

Please receive this resignation knowing I have been so blessed by the last 20 years at Independence Hill. Tanya, Jade, Hope, Carter and I are thankful for the relationships and memories. God has been good. My prayer has been and will continue to be that God will bless and keep this beautiful community of faith.
