# GOD IS ALWAYS AT WORK AMONG US

I think about the variety of impossible challenges that IHBC has faced and overcome throughout our 152 years as a Jesus-following church. We can't even imagine the insurmountable odds of launching a church, 152 years ago, that would outlast multiples of subsequent generations.

I bet there were moments when the people of IHBC thought, and even voiced, something like - "Well, this [issue, change, obstacle, loss, set-back, failure, decision, conflict...] might be the end of our church"

I bet there were times when it seemed like love wouldn't win.I bet there were misunderstandings and confusion.I bet there were times when relationships were fractured.

Isn't there a place in the Bible that says, *"Where two or three are gathered, there will be drama?"* (hahahaha)

Certainly, there were times in our church history, when the problems seemed insurmountable. The only thing they could see were the problems. And yet season after season, the people of IHBC would eventually realize this truth: **what's actually insurmountable is the LOVE and POWER of our God.** 

And 152 years later, here we are. God is faithful. Praise the Lord.

Praise God for the perseverance of multiple generations. Praise God for the sacrifices of generation after generation. Praise God for the wisdom of generation after generation. I know these last few months have been, well, CHALLENGING. Like me, I'm sure you've experienced a wide range of emotional responses, like sadness, anger, fear, relief, disappointment, confusion, nervousness, and even worry.

Your feelings are valid. Your feelings are normal. It's ok to have feelings – to name them, own them and talk about them with trusted others. After all, we are human.

But when we are under pressure, tired, anxious, or feeling threatened, our tendency is to depend on ourselves rather than God. I would encourage us to pay attention to this. God is ALWAYS at work cultivating our hearts, our character, to produce good fruit of **love**, **joy**, **peace**, **patience**, **kindness**, **goodness**, **gentleness**, **faithfulness** and **self-control**.

So be encouraged today. God is WITH us. All of us.

And God is GOOD. And **God's power is made perfect in our weakness.**  Victor Frankl, the holocaust survivor and Australian psychiatrist said *"Between STIMULUS and RESPONSE there is a space. In that space there is the power to CHOOSE our response. In our response lies our GROWTH and our FREEDOM."* 

In this season of IHBC's history, and in that space between Stimulus and Response, **let's** choose to LOVE LIKE JESUS.
